## SCHOOL PROFILE 2013-14

Silver Creek High School is a comprehensive 4-year high school located in the Evergreen Valley of East San Jose. In this area, there are many residential developments, including multiple-dwelling homes, and residential development has been on the increase. The parents represent a work force of blue-collar and white-collar workers. Forty six percent of our students come from families whose income qualifies them for the free or reduced lunch program and/or Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC). The socio-economic groups reflect lower/middle income families with a smaller number of upper income groups. Silver Creek offers a college-preparatory curriculum.
